VCA has been busier than ever in 2011. For this we are extremely grateful. We have had several large projects in the works at once. This spring we finished a beach house in Montauk with The Office of Thierry W. Despont and Wright Construction. Our work included a white lacquered kitchen, a large painted wall unit for the living room, and several pieces of custom furniture. In New York we have been working throughout the year on a residence for Victoria Blau. The kitchen, with a hand-rubbed

lacquer finish, and a black wire-brushed larch library have already been installed, with 30 black lacquered doors and jambs to follow. Suzanne Lovell's office approached us about a special finish they wanted for a Chicago project. After many hours of experimentation we came up with a sample they approved. VCA was awarded the contract to supply millwork for the dressing rooms, the study, master bedroom, master bath cabinetry, and 4 highly detailed pieces of custom furniture. We also coordinated and supplied 122 fabric panels for doors and cabinets and most of the custom metalwork and hardware. The millwork has been shipped and installed while the furniture is in production this fall.

Our long-standing clients, The Office of Thierry W. Despont and William T. Georgis, continue to supply us with a steady stream of work for their residential projects. OTD keeps us moving, from projects in Aspen to the Bahamas, and now back in New York with several pieces for a residence in The Plaza. From bullet holes to black lacquered tree stumps Bill Georgis always keeps us challenged with new decorative techniques.

In addition we have completed, or have in production, pieces for Eric Hilton, Charles Warren, Allen Kolkowitz, and Stuart Parr. As I said it has been a busy year.
